
SWACHH BHARAT

Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM) 2.0 Guidelines continue to take forward the aims of the SBM launched in 2014 along with solid waste management. Explain.

Swachh Bharat mission:

The mission was launched at 2nd of October 2014 a way to promote & develop global cleanliness as a part / Enacting the Environmental Protection Act of 1986 by Government of India.

Swachh Bharat Mission 2.0



Aim of Swachh Bharat Mission only with solid waste management

- To provide citizens with Health & liveable Atmosphere.
 - To curb further spread of disease epidemicity
 - prevent the degradation of land & water resources.
 - Developing Rural Infrastructure & promoting awareness of Education on clean surroundings & hygiene which was reflecting in "Swachh Survekshan Aङ्क" → Cleanliness Index.
 - Empowering funding from mission:
 - 1) State - 73.07% by the 15th Finance Commission of India.
 - 2) Central - 35%.
 - 3) UTB - 42%.
 - 100% to UT without legislative assembly
→ 90% HP, 80% to UT and so on.
 - Facilitating waste disposal mechanism & improving Organic fertilizer production
 - Usage of waste as fuel, increasing community participation.

Conclusion :

Though the aim was higher, we need fund to be released, Infrastructure should be made, Public participation should be removed, Technology has to be developed. So it could be able to achieve the target of free from old waste by 2023, as like the Mumbai, Varanasi, Visagapatnam, Gujarat has got good rank in cleanliness'
