

Q. Do you think that there is a need for a national urban employment scheme for better development in the country?

Analyze.

We always think that unemployment problem with rural areas but this is wrong, in urban areas millions of urban Indian residents are struggling without livelihood opportunities.

Some specific points needs to understand as follows:-

(i) The Standing Committee on Labour noted in its report of August 3, 2021 that "there is an imperative need for putting in place an employment guarantee programme for the urban workforce in line with MGNREGA."


(ii) The committee also came down on the central government for failing to collect data on the number and conditions of migrant workers, who experienced such suffering during the first lockdown.

(iii) March 2020, which restricted well beyond

initial expectations and damaged or destroyed livelihoods specially of informal workers and the urban poor.

(iv) By the survey of CMIE around 65% of the estimated job losses of nearly 20-million jobs lost between January-March 2020 and January - March 2021.
